- The BOGO drink card for their club was to make money for NKM. Manitowoc County did this. We should look into this for doing in the Sheboygan County area next year.
- The county representative and VP of NKM is Larry Rietbrock.
- Wayne Limberg made a motion that our club donate \$78.60 for Breakfast on the Farm. Hilari Fellows seconded the motion. Motion carried.
- Cody Wilterdink will be attending the convention.

Old Business

- Tom did not have time to look for a new laptop yet.

New Business

Wayne Limberg asked the secretary to close the nominations & cast a unanimous vote to close nominations. Ben Dorn will continue as a Trustee.
